**EMERGENCY ORDER**

Local Emergency Order for the Town of Amherst, County of Erie, in the State of New York:

I, *Brian Kulpa, Supervisor*, the Chief Executive of the Town of Amherst, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on *12/23/22 @ 0930hrs*, and pursuant to Sections 24 and 25 in Article 2B of the New York State Executive Law, do hereby order

*Travel Ban on all Town roads.*

*Essential medical, emergency service, school district personnel are exempt from this ban*

This order shall take effect *12/23/22 @ 0930hrs* and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless rescinded earlier by order of the Chief Executive. This order may also be renewed in (5) five-day increments.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law §24(5).
