EXECUTIVE ORDER # 2020.18

Declaration of Local State of Emergency in Response to COVID-19


WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, I issued an Executive Order declaring a local state of emergency in the Town of Amherst which has been extended through February 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, travel-related cases, public gathering cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and Erie County and are expected to continue;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Brian J. Kulpa, Supervisor of the Town of Amherst, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State of New York, do hereby issue this Executive Order dated January 22, 2021.

FURTHER, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Article 2B of the New York State Executive Law, I hereby extend to June 1, 2021 the Town of Amherst Guidelines for Temporary Outside Dining Permits per Resolution 2020-502 approved on June 8, 2020 and to also include restaurant permit renewals for 2021.
