

EXTENSION OF LOCAL DECLARATION OF "A STATE OF EMERGENCY"

"A State of Emergency" is herewith declared in the Town of Amherst, County of Erie, in the State of New York, for the period beginning August 23, 2021 is hereby extended to January 23, 2022.

A State of Emergency has been declared due to the region having entered into the Centers of Disease Control "High Risk" transmission category along with the evolving challenges to protect the public health and safety related to the spread of COVID-19 affecting all of the Town of Amherst. Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of the Town of Amherst.

As the Supervisor of the Town of Amherst, I, Brian J. Kulpa have exercised the authority given to me in sections 24 and 25 in Article 2B of the New York State Executive Law to preserve public safety and I hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Town.

I hereby direct all departments to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary or as otherwise outlined in my emergency orders dated August 23, 2021.
