

FIRE LANE GUIDE LOCAL LAW #4-82

Requirements:

- A. New or Expanded Projects
 - 1. Designated fire lane shall be at least 25 ft. wide if for two-way traffic, 18 ft. wide if for one-way traffic.
 - 2. Driveway to street radius shall be at least 34 ft.
 - 3. Fire lane shall provide access to and/or around the structure(s).
 - 4. When practical there shall be no parking provided between the fire lane(s) and structure(s)
 - 5. If parking must be placed between the fire lane(s) and the building provide minimum 24 ft. wide access (walks or landscaped islands) at least every 99 ft.
 - 6. All required signage and/or pavement markings must be installed prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy.
- B. Existing sites required to designate Fire Lane(s):
 - 1. Driveways which intersect with a public road or highway may be designated a fire lane.
 - 2. The driveways closest and parallel to the structure shall be designated a fire lane.
 - 3. Required signs and/or pavement markings shall be installed within 90 days following the adoption of the Planning Board resolution requiring the fire lane.
- C. Fire Lanes shall be indicated by:
 - 1. Fire Lane signs shall conform to the requirements of subchapter B, standard regulatory signs, Part 214 of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. (Sign P-10)
 - 2. Signs shall be mounted on posts spaced not more than 100 ft. apart along driveways designated per item b. 1 above, and on building walls or canopy supports as appropriate at a spacing not exceeding 50 ft.
 - 3. The Planning Board may require the words "FIRE LANE" be painted on the pavement in conformance with Part 260 of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and shall be 6 ft. in height. Words shall be painted so that they are legible to approaching traffic.

D. Inspection:

1. The Fire Safety Division of the Building department shall verify the installation of the signs and/or pavement markings as shown on the approved plan.

- 1. Signs shall be located on the right hand side of the roadway facing approaching traffic.
- 2. Signs shall be installed approximately two feet away from the edge of pavement or curb.
- 3. The bottom of the sign shall be at least seven (7) feet above finished grade.
- 4. All signs shall be installed facing traffic at an angle of 30 to 45 degrees to a line parallel to the flow of traffic. The sign legends shall include single-headed arrows pointing in the direction of the regulated fire lane if the signs are located at the end of the zone, or double-headed arrows pointing in both directions if the signs are at intermediate locations.
