The Town provides engraving services to inscribe the names of individual United States Military Veterans, both living and deceased. The memorial is flanked on both sides by granite panels.

The Amherst Veterans Memorial was created in 2009 as a permanent site to honor living and deceased individuals who served in our Nation's military and have a residency/familial connection to the Town of Amherst.



A limestone wall, featuring cast bronze seals of the United States Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Space Force & Coast Guard forms the centerpiece of the memorial. Water, symbolic of life, flows from the stone beneath each medallion and collects in a reflecting pool at the base of the wall.
