

## **EXECUTIVE ORDER # 2020.14**

## Declaration of Local State of Emergency in Response to COVID-19

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, I issued an Executive Order declaring a local state of emergency in the Town of Amherst which has been extended through November 15th; and

WHEREAS, travel-related cases, public gathering cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and Erie County;

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, I, Brian J. Kulpa, Supervisor of the Town of Amherst, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of New York, do hereby issue this Executive Order dated October 15, 2020, and I hereby continue any suspension or modification of law made by this Executive Order.

Under this authority, the Supervisor is hereby authorizing the Town Board meeting of November 9<sup>th</sup> along with all other boards and committees to continue to hold their meetings virtually with public participation.
