NEW TRAFFIC SIGNALS COMING SOON TO NORTH BAILEY AVENUE

Motorists Advised of Roadway Improvements

Supervisor Brian Kulpa announces that in anticipation of new retail on North Bailey Avenue, including Dick's House of Sport and Costco, the Town of Amherst announces traffic improvements along North Bailey. Work has been underway throughout the spring and summer with two traffic signals expected to be installed the week of October 20. It is anticipated they will be operational by the end of the month. The two new traffic signals will be installed as follows: 1) Romney Road and North Bailey Avenue 2) the BestBuy driveway and North Bailey Avenue.

North Bailey Avenue, north of Romney Road, was recently repaved and striping has begun. The improvements added turn lanes into the Dick's/Costco plaza at both of the new traffic signals. Motorists should use caution in the area while final striping work is performed. The resurfacing follows the realignment of Romney Road to line up with the entrance for the Costco, which was completed over the summer. The enhancements will improve safety and

assist with traffic flow in the area as The Boulevard shopping center has developed in recent years, and in anticipation of the addition of the stores on the east side of North Bailey Avenue.

Motorists will be made aware of the changes to the roadway through “New Traffic Pattern” signage and “New Signal Operation Ahead” signage that is being installed concurrently with the traffic signals. The public should be aware of these new improvements and take care while driving through that area.

The project also included the installation of MioVision at the signalized intersections to ensure that traffic moves as efficiently as possible, reducing backups and harmful emissions.

The outlined projects are developer funded roadway improvements.
