After Joel Dombrowski had a career in Broadcast Journalism, he began applying his storytelling skills to his lifelong passion--Buffalo's history. He owns and operates Buffalo Double Decker Bus, which provides humorous, historical tours of the city. Trip Advisor calls his tours "The #1 Thing to do in Buffalo." In addition to writing tour guide books, he also creates and appears in murder mystery performances that have been staged on the ships at the Buffalo Naval Park, inside grain silos at Riverworks, aboard moving trains and the Hotel Lafayette.
